Dear Minneapolis taxpayer,

The Public Works Department *is cancelling* the informational meeting in your neighborhood scheduled for Wednesday April 1 at the Whittier Park Rec Center due to the current coronavirus and recommendations to limit large group gatherings. The City's website has been updated to answer most of the questions you might have on this upcoming project.

This resurfacing project is part of the Public Works ongoing street improvement program. The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the streets in this area by replacing the old asphalt surface with a new layer of asphalt. Doing this will extend the life of this street and delay more time consuming and expensive repairs to these streets. There are no other changes or street improvements planned.
