

# **Non-Profit Vendor Info and Registration**

<u>About the event</u>: The Eat Street Food Music and Arts Festival is a celebration of all things Eat Street and the Whittier neighborhood. Drawing over 6,000 attendees in its inaugural year in 2018, the Eat Street Festival strives to bring all facets of community together by providing programming and opportunities representative of the broad diversity of the Whittier neighborhood.

This form applies to vendors with a 501(c)3 or 501(c)4 status who wish to display or advertise their services at the Eat Street Food, Music and Arts Festival 2019.

## What are the costs to be a nonprofit vendor?

• The one-time registration fee for non-profit vendors is \$100.00 must be submitted by July 31st. Please include your payment preference on page 2.

## What do you need to bring to the event?

Whittier Alliance will assign you a location within the Festival grounds. *You are responsible for bringing all materials that you will need:* 

- Your own 10x10' (maximum) tent, folding tables, chairs, etc.
- A generator, if you require power.

**Note:** If this presents a significant barrier to participation, assistance may be available. Contact <u>business@whittieralliance.org</u> or 612-871-7756 for more info

#### What time should you set up and take down?

- Set up: You have between 10:30 am-12:00 pm to set up. (More details will be provided in late August.)
- Take down: You should be packed up and have vacated your designated location by 9pm.
  - **NOTE:** Vendors are required to stay until at least 7:00 pm; if you need to leave before then, you must coordinate your departure plan with Whittier Alliance in advance.

# What else do you need to know?

- Vendors are responsible for leaving their designated area as they found it.
- The Whittier Alliance will be in contact with you as we get closer to the event date with further details and booth location.
- Preference will be given to organizations who are located in or have a strong connection to Whittier neighborhood.
- Booths may be shared by multiple organizations. Please fill out the registration form for each organization and submit them jointly. Whittier Alliance will only receive full payment from one vendor.
- Participation is not guaranteed and is subject to availability and Whittier staff approval.
