Obviously, this meeting is very near - we were just added to the agenda this past Thursday. As for the rest of the formal neighborhood process, we are scheduled to return to the May 17 Committee meeting to report on design progress as we work towards appearing at the June 26 Planning Commission agenda for project approval.

A little background on us: Heirloom Properties is a family-owned real estate development company based here in South Minneapolis.
