- **Survey Questions**

- We decided to postpone drafting the survey questions for when more taskforce members are present.

- Before we survey the community, the questions will need to be approved by our Board representative (Brett), and subsequently approved by the WA executive director (Marian). The process should not take long and can be handled during business hours as opposed to a formal meeting.

- **Whittier International School – Signage**

- Greg will verify, but at first glance he noticed there is no signage indicating lower speed limits/school zone around Whittier School. He contacted the school and he received a voicemail from Beth Mason stating that they never noticed this before. Greg will continue to try and connect with Beth in order to get the school's support on getting proper school zone signage on the surrounding blocks. Paul will contact Public Works to find out protocol and the school's PTA to conjure up additional support.

- **Other**

- According to the Traffic Enforcement data we received last week, 27th & Nicollet was the only intersection along 27th St that was being enforced for non-moving violations. Greg has indicated Traffic Enforcement has now been ticketing other intersections along 27th St as of last week.

- Question arose whether or not Public Works pays for signage to protect bikers/pedestrians. Paul will inquire with Public Works.

- All future proposals to Ward 10 and Public Works will need approval from Whittier Alliance Board and/or Executive Director.

- **Task Delegation**

- Paul: contact Public Works regarding school signage protocol and bike/pedestrian signage costs. Contact Whittier School's PTA to get them familiarized with lack of school signage.

- Greg: analyze blocks around school for (lack of) signage. Connect with Beth Mason at Whittier School.

- All: start thinking of survey questions.
